English



As readers, we will focus on:

*Discussing and expressing our views on classic poetry

*Discussing and clarifying the meaning of words

*Discussing our favourite words and phrases

*Improving our fluency

As writers, we will:

Y2

*Continue to work on developing our stamina for writing *Consistently construct sentences using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

*Use expanded noun phrases for description *use adjectives to create atmosphere

Y3

*Use headings and sub-headings to aid presentation *Express time, place and cause using conjunctions

*Begin to structure our writing into paragraphs

*Read aloud our own writing, using appropriate intonation

Music

As Musicians we will learn that Music has a pulse and is made up of long and short and high and low sounds. We will explore the pulse, rhythm and pitch through song and through the use of instruments.



Science

As scientists, we will recognise that in order to see things we need light, whilst understanding the light from the sun can also be harmful.

Year 2 will focus on asking simple questions and understanding they can be answered in different ways, using scientific language to support their answer.

Year 3 will focusing on asking relevant questions and use different types of scientific enquiries to answer them.

We will also observe visual changes across the seasons, focussing on the change from Summer to Autumn.

Art

As **artists**, we will use a range of drawing materials to create detailed observational drawings. Using a block print method, these drawing will be transferred into prints.

PE

As gymnasts, we will apply 'champion' gymnastic skills to our movements and balances in wide, narrow and curled

ways on the floor and on apparatus. We will develop simple sequences, linking movements together.



As footballers, we will develop moving the ball using our feet, applying this to dribbling as well. We will explore passing the ball by kicking it to score a point.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will focus on:

Y2

*Place value: numbers within 100 *Teens numbers – unpick understanding *Adding subtracting 3 1-digit numbers *Bridging 10

Y3

*Counting past 100

*Partitioning three digit numbers

*Composition and calculation to 100 and bridging 100



Geography

As Geographers, we will name and locate the seas surrounding the UK, as well the five oceans and seven continents around the world on a world map or globe. We will locate the equator and the North and South Poles on a map. We will draw and read a range of simple maps that use symbols and a key and recognise the significance of a place. In addition, we will learn about the

four cardinal points on a compass, using these to create routes from one place to another.



ICT

As programmers, Y2 will focus on describing some uses of computers and identify and understand they are part of IT.

Y3 will be introduced to computer networks that include network infrastructure devices like routers and switches.
