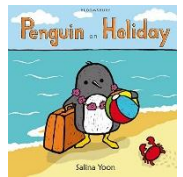
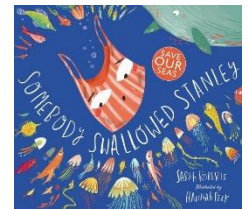
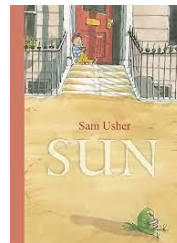

Literacy Nursery Learn some set 1 sounds Write some / all letters of their name Use some print / letter knowledge in early writing / play / give meaning to marks Reception Read and write words and simple sentences consistent with phonic knowledge Write simple sentences with some common exception words, that can be read by others	Maths Nursery Sing number rhymes & count in their play Subitise and link numeral to amount to 5 Cardinal principle & correspondence to 5 capacity Reception Have a deep understanding of numbers to 5 and 10, including their composition Automatically recall number bonds to 5 and some to 10, including some subtraction facts Doubling numbers to 10 capacity odd and even numbers.
